#### 5. President's Report

The President presented her report, focusing on –

#### • Role of the MYA Board -

- Safeguarding the efficient delivery of quality services to their member clubs by Australian Sailing
- Providing advice and representation on State/Territory priorities and issues
- Providing regular input into national strategy and priorities
- Holding the Australian Sailing Board to account
- Managing retained local assets and investing returns into priority areas as determined by the MYA Board.

#### • Committee Reviews -

- The current review of all committees national is well underway. YV has been assisting Australian Sailing in the development of this review.
- Glen Stanaway at Australian Sailing is now collating all the data from these reviews to enable a recommendation to be made to all MYA Boards.

#### • Sailing World Cup and beyond -

- The executive committee is working to establish a new long term regatta under the Sail Melbourne brand that is not reliant on World Sailing.
- The committee is going to the Victorian government to shore up future funding.





#### State Sailing Centre –

- The renovation of the Boatshed into a State Sailing Center is still on track and has ORCV as a major partner/tenant.
- Quotes for the renovation have proven to be higher than expected and extra funding is being sort from the Victorian Government.
- Due to the funding shortfall two plans have been finalised for the renovation and the final plan will be dependent on funding.

# • Communications -

- Australian Sailing has launched a new campaign titled "Wind, Water and You".
- In a previous survey clubs across the nation indicated that they were receiving too many emails from the governing body. With that in mind Australian Sailing are utilising their monthly newsletters to inform clubs of relevant information. State specific information can be found by scrolling down through the newsletter to your relevant state section.

#### Performance Program Appraisal –

Matt Carroll wrote a piece on this in the latest club newsletter and was happy to answer any specific questions.

# • Participation Census -

 Cherry Birch thanked all the clubs that took part in the census. The response rate was higher than last year and this important information helps secure the ASC funding for our sport.

#### Club Satisfaction Survey –

- This survey was sent out to all clubs today. The YV Board is very interested in the results of this survey and the clubs' feedback.

Mark Taylor (BRYC) asked for assurance that any past (prior to One Sailing) YV surpluses were to be spent within Victoria. Mark also asked that clubs be kept informed of where any retained earnings and/or cash assets were spent.

#### 8. Australian Sailing Update

Regional Manager Gavin Wall gave a report outlining the continued success of Discover Sailing within Victoria and the fact that membership numbers in Victoria had reached 26,294 as at the end of February. He also reported on the work done by clubs around the new Child Safety Standards, the success and subsequent modification of the Performance Coaching Program and the continued work done with Race Official (RO) courses. Of note was the all-female RO course run in February that had to be capped at 25 participants.

Gavin then made mention of the great number of events that had taken place in Victoria over the season. This include World, Nationals, State, off shore and local level events. He reminded everyone of the upcoming events such as the Victorian Instructors conference (17 June), Victorian Sailing awards (18 June), Regional Roadshows and the Victorian Club Conference (12 August).

#### 9. General Business

Neville Rose (ORCV) mentioned to the audience that the Volvo around the World Race was stopping over in Melbourne in December. It is hoped the yachts will arrived around the 23<sup>rd</sup> of December 2017. There is a Pro Am event scheduled on the bay.
