

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of Yachting Victoria Incorporated held at the Albert Park Yacht Club 7.00pm on Monday 21 September 2015 MINUTES

1. Meeting Opened & Welcome by President, Ian Cunningham

The President welcomed everyone to the meeting, thanked them for attending and thanked the Albert Park Yacht Club for hosting the meeting.

5. President's Report –

The President presented his report, and featured the following aspects of it -

- From a Board perspective it had been a particularly busy year with One Sailing being a key feature. The President thanked the YV Board members for their efforts in this 'space' including the additional meetings, reading and negotiations. The President added that whilst this was still in process he hoped that the benefits would materialise in the near future.
- The Membership and Category Review process had been a significant task during the period and he thanked all clubs for participating as well as Treasurer Cherry Birch for her significant role.
- The effort by all clubs to provide sailing opportunities and to grow the sport statewide, thanking them all for this.
- The regattas and events that had been conducted and in particular the clubs that successfully hosted States, Nationals and Worlds.
- Thanks to the YV staff and the CEO Steve Walker for the dedicated role during the period and the progress made.
- Thanks to retiring Board Member Marg Douglas for her valuable threeyear contribution as a Board member.

6. CEO Report

The CEO, Steve Walker spoke to his report which had been circulated previously via email as part of the Annual Report. The CEO thanked the President and Board, the various 'leaders and decision makers' at clubs, the many committee chairs and members, and the YV staff for all of their contributions during 14/15. The CEO went on to thank Club Marine, Gill, OTB Marine, William Angliss, Mercedes, VicHealth, Sport and Rec Victoria, New Tack, and VicSport for great contributions during the year. The CEO then noted the most pleasing aspects of the year had been further growth in participation, membership, courses, junior activity, race official development, Sailability and the ISAF SWC. The CEO summarised by reflecting on the strong sense of shared objectives between the clubs and YV, in terms of developing sailing, that is in place.

The CEO Report was received.

7. Treasurer's report

The report, as previously circulated via email/link was discussed. The Treasurer outlined the 'sound' position that YV was in, however explained the main causes for the year's deficit. These being an excessive Leave Accrual due to untaken annual leave, the non-payment of an otherwise earned Tackers bonus from YA, and a very surprising Boatshed deficit that only materialised after the departure of the previous manager. The Treasurer went on to report that the result, whilst disappointing was 'palatable', and that for 15/16 and beyond this would not happen again.

It was confirmed that KPMG had approved the full audited accounts and the version on the website would be updated the following day inclusive of the KPMG partner sign off.

11. General Business

Life Membership Nomination

Sean Hogan (Training Committee Chair) spoke with regard to the major contribution over more than 20 years of Doug King. Inclusion

Inclusion Manager Sam Watson provided a brief update with a focus on recent Women and Girls in Sailing initiatives, Sailability programs and the Inclusive Club Standard. Sam noted that 26 clubs had now adopted the Inclusive Club Standard and that more clubs were encouraged to follow suit.

Discover Sailing

Discover Sailing Manager Gavin Wall provided a brief update in relation to Discover Sailing and in particular the quantum of participating clubs, the success of some of the 'days' and other activities, the growth in course numbers and the overall importance for clubs to fully engage. Gavin assured clubs that those that are actively adopting Discover Sailing principles are having success.

Sailing/Events

The CEO Steve Walker provided a brief update covering the major regattas and sailing events for the upcoming season, the various series (such as the Club Marine Series and the OTB Marine Vic Sailing Cup), the Race Official development opportunities, and the junior/youth coaching activities. The importance of supporting these activities and developing the 'pipeline' of future sailors was emphasised.

Participation Survey

Ian Cunningham advised that YA was about to circulate a very important Participation Survey that it hoped all clubs would support. The survey was designed to provide accurate data, help with decision making, and to bolster funding opportunities. In particular, as part of One Sailing, this information will be very important from an Australian Sports Commission perspective and Ian encouraged clubs to respond as requested when the survey arrives.
